H5 Avian Influenza in the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc

This is an important communication regarding biosecurity and quarantine provisions on your poultry farm.

CFIA Primary Control Zones

CFIA will establish a Primary Control Zone (PCZ), in the area where the disease has been identified. Use the following link to access CFIA's maps, which will be updated: <u>Avian Influenza Control Zones.</u>

Please implement heightened biosecurity immediately!

In the interim, as CFIA works to establish and announce the PCZ, please reinforce heightened biosecurity protocols including minimizing the movement of birds, people and equipment on and off of your farm - and within the described area. Biosecurity protocols can be accessed on the <u>FBCC website</u>.
